Kelley-Drake and Smoke Rise town owned properties along the shores of and an island in Pemigewasset Lake.

- The property follows the south west shore of Pemigewasset Lake that is in Belknap County, with land gaining in elevation as one walks south away from the lake frontage.
- There are wet areas near the lake front and older growths of pines and hard woods as you gain elevation.
- There is a large field that slopes upward from the low forested areas that is rimed by apple trees.
- At the apex of a small knoll is a cellar hole from the former Drake farmhouse.
- Smoke Rise consists of several wooded lots in a private development which have no direct lake frontage.
- The island is wooded and can be reached by watercraft.
